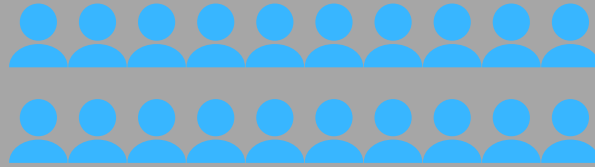
First in-text citation lists up to 5 authors of a work
